Begin your day by grabbing breakfast at **Cindy's Kitchen**, which will start your morning out right. Cindy has many homemade croissants and biscuits ready for you right when you walk in the door. Next up – catch the FREE **Currituck Sound Ferry** over to Knott's Island, but make sure you bring some bread for the hungry seagulls! Please call ahead to get the updated ferry times at 252-232-2683. Once you make it over to Knott's Island, be certain to take a wildlife adventure by exploring the **Charles Kuralt Trail**. There's no particular route for the trail - plan your travels according to your time, interest, and what each season may offer. For example, spring is a great time for experiencing songbird migration. If you didn't get a chance to pack up your lunch for a picnic, grab lunch at the local **Knott's Island Market** which hosts a deli and pizza shop. In the afternoon, visit the lovely vineyards, such as **Martin Orchard and Vineyard** and **Moonrise Bay Vineyard**. When in season, you may also be able to pick fruits, such as apples, peaches, grapes, and more. Learn more about their history and the winemaking processes that each use. So bring the family, a picnic lunch, and make a day of it! Head home early on the ferry or stay for dinner at **Pearl's Bay Villa Marina and Restaurant** and drive a scenic route back. Pearl's offers a beautiful view over the bay with home-made dinner specials.

## Directions to Knott's Island

1. Take Hwy 168 North
2. Right on Gallbush at the light
3. Right on Indian Creek at T-intersection
4. Left on Sanderson
5. Right on Hungarian
6. Left on Blackwater
7. Right on Pungo Ferry
8. Go across the bridge
9. Right on Princess Anne
10. Go straight on Princess Anne (all the way to Knott's Island)
