The Currituck Wine Trail

Currituck County, North Carolina is home to three family-run wineries, each providing a distinct taste unique for the consumer. Two of which are just a free ferry ride over to Knott's Island. Moonrise Bay and Martin Vineyards both grow and produce wines from scuppernong grapes, but unlike most coastal wineries, they are grow and produce viniferous grapes. Within walking distance of each other, both wineries offer picnic areas with vineyard and island views.

A) Moonrise Bay Vineyard and Winery
